Changes to CACS Reentry Plan:

- 1. On July 22, 2020, Governor Holcomb mandated masks for all students in grades 3 through 12, and recommended masks be worn by grades 2 and below. Students on the bus and in the school building will be required to wear masks while in the buildings and should only take them off when eating, drinking, and during rigorous activity. Rose Hamilton students and teachers will work together to learn the proper ways to wear masks, discuss when it is necessary to wear masks, and will follow the same protocol as the other buildings when deemed necessary by the teachers and administration. - 2. Centerville-Abington Community Schools strives to provide the best educational opportunities for all of their students. Due to the needed additions regarding alternative education for students remaining at home due to the COVID-19 virus, we will be adjusting the start time for the school day. All schools will now start classes 30 minutes later than their normal start times. This change still meets the requirements set forth by the Indiana Department of Education and will allow students at home to contact teachers and receive needed help on school work. WCC students' schedules will not change. The schedule is as follows: (Page 4: New addition to: Schedules)

Rose Hamilton: Transfer students will leave Centerville-Abington Elementary at 8:30. School will begin at 8:40 and will end at 2:40.

Centerville-Abington Elementary: CAE classes will start at 8:30 and end at 3:00.

Centerville Junior High School: Start time 8:30 and release time 3:00. Homeroom classes will not meet and the schedule will start with students in their 1B or 1W classes.

Centerville Senior High School: Start time 8:30 and release time 3:00. WCC students will leave at the normal time in the morning and return at the normal time after school. Homeroom classes will not meet and the schedule will start with students in their 1B or 1W classes.

Teacher schedules will start at 7:45 in all buildings.

Additional changes from CDC and Wayne County Health Department: (Page 4: Exclusion)

The CDC no longer recommends the testing based strategy to determine when to discontinue home isolation.

Symptom based criteria has been modified as follows:

- Changed from "at least 72 hours" to "at least 24 hours" have passed since last fever without the use of fever reducing medications.
- Change from "improvement in respiratory symptoms" to "improvement in symptoms" to address the expanding list of symptoms associated with COVID-19.
