

Message from the Superintendent

Centerville-Abington Community Schools has a long history of being one of the highest performing schools in Wayne County and in the State of Indiana. All four of our schools have been designated as “Indiana Four Star Schools” which means that our schools rank in the top 25% in the state in test scores. We are also the only school in Wayne County that is district accredited through AdvancED/NCA and seventh school in the state to be so accredited in 2007. The rigor of a district accreditation indicates that Centerville-Abington Community Schools can compete academically with the best in the state. We offer a wide range of Advanced Placement programs and also an academically talented program. Our students attend the Whitewater Technical Career Center which is one of the best technical career programs in the state. Because of the eight block schedule at Centerville Senior High School, our students are also able to post-secondary classes at Ivy Tech, IU East, Purdue at IU East and Earlham College. Students are able to take our online classes through PLATO.

Our schools also provide excellent extra-curricular facilities and activities. Our school offers many activities that other schools in the area do not provide. We offer soccer, swimming and bowling and our music and art programs are excellent. We are also the only school in the county that provides before and after school childcare from 6:00 a.m. until school starts and from after school until 6:00 p.m. at each elementary school .

Centerville-Abington Community Schools provides a small school atmosphere with big school offerings and we are proud of our schools in being able to provide our community with these opportunities.
