The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building with the following members present: Brad Lambright, Andy Wandersee, Susan Hamilton, Renee Westover, and Todd Duke. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Motion by Renee Westover, second by Todd Duke, to approve the consent items as presented. 5 ayes – 0 nays. Documentation follows.

Sam Pritchard, recently hired as the new Rose Hamilton Elementary principal, was introduced to the Board of Trustees.

Kelly VanWinkle recognized Maizy Martin, Anna Nevels, and Brady Moore for their Science Fair achievements.

Brad Lambright opened the floor to community comments. There were no comments and the floor was closed by Mr. Lambright.

Item 15 from New Business was moved up on the agenda:

- Jarrett Rusznak, high school student, presented an Eagle Scout project proposal to the Board for consideration. Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover, to approve the Eagle Scout project proposal as presented. 5 ayes – 0 nays.

Old Business:

- Consider Board policy #5460. Motion by Todd Duke, second by Renee Westover, to approve Board policy #5460 as presented. 5 ayes – 0 nays.

New Business (continued):

 - o Reported that the maintenance personnel were re-purposing the aluminum bleacher boards from the old football bleachers. The aluminum boards are being used on the softball bleachers.
 - o Noted that the school bus drivers would be participating in the annual state stop arm violation survey.

- Susan Hamilton noted that parents of several Kindergarten transfer students obtained school information from the flyers that had been sent out.
- Renee Westover congratulated Tiffani Thornburg on being selected Teacher of the Year.
