The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 6:45 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building to hold an informational meeting on the tentative teacher contract as required by SEA 390. The following members were present: Todd Duke, Andy Wandersee, and Brad Lambright. Renee Westover was present via Zoom. Susan Hamilton arrived at 6:50 p.m. via Zoom.

The tentative 2020-2021 teacher collective bargaining agreement is posted on the school website. The tentative 2020-2021 teacher collective bargaining agreement includes the following provisions:

No changes to the compensation schedule.

No changes to the extra-curricular compensation schedule.


4% increase in health insurance premium contributions paid by the school corporation.

An agreement, when state funding for the school year is finalized, that 85% of State Tuition Support Fund will be used to cover teacher compensation including salary increments and the health insurance contributions. After these expenditures, any remaining monies from 85% of the State Tuition Support Fund will be divided equally among teachers as a stipend.

There were no questions from those in the board room or participating via Zoom.

The meeting adjourned at 6:59 p.m. with a motion by Andy Wandersee, seconded by Todd Duke. Those voting in favor were: Renee Westover, Todd Duke, Brad Lambright, Andy Wandersee, and Susan Hamilton. Motion passed 5-0.
