

April 22, 2015

The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building with the following members present: Brad Lambright, Renee Westover, Susan Hamilton, Andy Wandersee, and Mark Baldwin. The meeting was opened by Brad Lambright with the Pledge of Allegiance to the American flag.

Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Renee Westover, to approve the consent items as presented. 5 ayes – 0 nays. Documentation follows.

Brad Lambright opened the floor to community comments. There were no comments and the floor was closed by Mr. Lambright.

Old Business: None

New Business:

- Brad Lambright suggested the Board select a representative to serve as a legislative liaison. Motion by Renee Westover, second by Andy Wandersee, to appoint Brad Lambright as the legislative liaison. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- Mr. Stevenson requested someone from the Board to serve on the selection committee for a new High School Guidance Counselor. Andy Wandersee volunteered to serve on the selection committee.
- Mr. Stevenson requested the Board to consider the 2016 – 2017 School Corporation Calendar. Tabled for further discussion.
- Mrs. Hokey (CAE Assistant Principal) requested the Board to consider hiring an additional 5th grade teacher due to a projected increase in class sizes. Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Renee Westover, to approve the hiring of an additional 5th grade teacher for 2015 – 2016. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- Mrs. Hokey requested the Board to consider hiring an additional special education teacher due to increased demand; she also proposed to reduce three special education aides to offset the cost. Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Andy Wandersee, to approve the hiring of a special education teacher and reduction of three special education aides at Centerville-Abington Elementary for the 2015 – 2016 school year. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- Brad Lambright reminded the Board that the spring ISBA meeting is on May 7th in Hagerstown. No action required.
- Ed Soots from LWC Inc updated the Board on the Rose Hamilton Elementary construction project. No action required.
- Mr. Campbell updated the Board on the following support services areas:
 - o Mr. Campbell requested the Board to consider a buy-out of the lease on the mobile classroom at Rose Hamilton due to the cost of relocating the structure to another spot and an assurance from Mr. Stienbarger (Principal, Rose Hamilton Elementary) that they could make-do for with existing space for one year on those classroom locations. Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Andy Wandersee, to authorize a buy-out of the lease from Tyson Onsite. 5 ayes – 0 nays.

- Noted that the bleacher hand rail installation project in the high school gymnasiums was complete and showed pictures of the finished project.
- Estimated that the start of the West Gymnasium floor sanding and repainting project would be the first week of June.
- Discussed a pre-bid meeting for the Junior High Roofing project and that bids will be due at 1:00 PM on April 30, 2015
- Reported on an expected delay for receiving a new activity bus due to inventory issues at General Motors.

Additional Items:

- Susan Hamilton reported on the High Ability meeting she attended at Centerville-Abington Elementary.
- Brad Lambright reported on the Centerville-Abington Elementary School Improvement Committee meeting that he had attended.

Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Andy Wandersee, to adjourn the meeting at 8:04 PM. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
