The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building with the following members present: Renee Westover, Susan Hamilton, Mark Baldwin, and Andy Wandersee. Brad Lambright was absent. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Mark Baldwin, to approve the consent items as presented. 4 ayes – 0 nays. Documentation follows.

Renee Westover opened the floor to community comments. There were no comments and the floor was closed by Mrs. Westover

Brad Lambright arrived for the meeting at 7:02 PM.

Mark Howell (Athletic Director) discussed high school fall sports and conference standings. He invited the coaches to speak about specific team accomplishments and hand out Centerville-Abington Community Schools Awards of Excellence to athletes who had outstanding accomplishments.

Old Business:

New Business:

- Mr. Campbell presented a proposal from Lee Stienbarger to add a part time crossing guard position at Rose Hamilton Elementary and noted that there is a justified need for adding the position. - Mr. Campbell reviewed the Corporation project list with the Board and asked for permission to begin two of the projects (concrete work at the high school and adding a key swipe to a door at the new Rose Hamilton addition). Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Brad Lambright, to approve concrete work at the high school and adding a key swipe to a door at the Rose Hamilton Elementary addition. 5 ayes – 0 nays.

- Mr. Stevenson presented additional professional leave requests for consideration . Motion by Mark Baldwin, second by Brad Lambright, to approve the additional professional leave requests as presented. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- Mr. Stevenson discussed the Corporation ISTEP results and how they compared to area schools.
- Susan Hamilton mentioned that she had attended the recent Corporation School Improvement meeting.
