

April 12, 2017

The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building with the following members present: Mark Baldwin, Renee Westover, Susan Hamilton, Brad Lambright, and Andy Wandersee. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Renee Westover, to approve consent items as presented. 5 ayes – 0 nays. Documentation follows.

Mark Baldwin opened the floor to community comments. There were no comments and the floor was closed by Mr. Baldwin.

Mark Howell discussed the winter sports season and introduced the coaches of each team. Jason Searcy (Girls basketball), Mike Day (wrestling), Seve Beach (Boys basketball), and Darren Ridenour (swimming) spoke about the successes of their respective teams and presented Centerville-Abington Community Schools Awards of Excellence to outstanding team members.

Old Business: Consider multiple Board policies. Tabled for further discussion.

New Business:

- Mike McCoy discussed a plan for utilizing the former industrial arts rooms at the high school. He would like to convert it into an art room. He discussed the benefits of converting that room for the arts program. No action required.
- Mike McCoy, Rick Schauss, and Kelly VanWinkle discussed changes to the band program that they feel would improve student participation and enhance the overall program. No action required.
- Mark Baldwin noted that the upcoming ISBA Spring meeting was scheduled on a Board meeting night and that if Centerville-Abington Schools Board members wanted to attend, then a change in the meeting date would be necessary. Motion by Renee Westover, second by Andy Wandersee, to change the May 10, 2017 scheduled Board meeting to May 8, 2017. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- Mr. Campbell presented a recommendation from the Compensation Committee to approve a 1% raise for the non-teaching staff not including the Administration. He noted that combined with the 1.5% from the previous July, this would be 2% for the year, which is in line with inflation. Motion by Renee Westover, second by Andy Wandersee, to approve a 1% raise for the non-teaching staff effective immediately. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- Mr. Campbell reported on the following support services areas: A. Reported that a pre-bid meeting on the Rose Hamilton roofing projects will be on April 24 and the bid opening will be at 1:00 PM on May 5, 2017. B. Discussed the need to repair/replace sidewalks on that North & West sides of Centerville-Abington Elementary. C. Noted that the new Special Education bus is scheduled for delivery on April 24.

- Susan Hamilton discussed the Student High Ability meeting she recently attended.
- Renee Westover discussed the Rose Hamilton School Improvement meeting she recently attended.
