The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building with the following members present: Susan Hamilton, Brad Lambright, Todd Duke and Andy Wandersee. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Motion by Susan Hamilton, second by Todd Duke, to approve the consent items as presented. 4 ayes – 0 nays. Documentation follows.

Brad Lambright opened the floor to community comments. There were no comments and the floor was closed by Brad Lambright.

- None

New Business:

- The board considered a proposal by CGI Communications to produce a video promoting Centerville-Abington Schools on the City of Richmond website. This would also be on the EDC and Waynet website. Various businesses in Richmond, including Reid Hospital and the City of Richmond, are promoting this proposal to attract families to the Richmond area. Motion to approve by Todd Duke, second by Renee Westover with the contingent that Mr. Stevenson gets more information concerning the payment and start date. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- The school board considered the proposal to hire a behavior specialist. Motion to approve by Susan Hamilton, second by Renee Westover. 5 ayes – 0 nays.
- The school board considered the proposal to hire an additional social worker at K-8 grades. This was for school safety and also to reduce the number of students under the social workers after the retirement of Mr. Peine. Motion to approve by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover. 5 ayes – 0 nays.

Additional Items:

- Susan Hamilton gave an update on the meeting with financial audit for the fiscal years ending 2015 and 2016. The auditors said this would cost the school corporation about \$10,000 and would be completed on around October 1.
- Renee Westover mentioned the amount of money that had been raised by a teacher for local students participating in the 4-H livestock auction. She also mentioned that they were still collecting money for the students.
