The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building. The following members were physically present: Todd Duke, Brad Lambright, Andy Wandersee, and Renee Westover. The following member was not present: Susan Hamilton. The public observed the meeting via in-person or through Zoom. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover to approve the consent items as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation follows.

Todd Duke thanked donors for two donations. He thanked Hill Electric for a \$250 donation and Walter Lake for a \$500 donation to the Joe Lake Memorial Bulldog 5k. This year's Bulldog 5k is named in honor of Joe Lake, former Centerville Bulldog runner and current 5k record holder.

Mr. Osting presented athletes who earned Tri-Eastern All-Conference honors and/or were Sectional winners this Spring. Mr. Osting introduced Coach Randy Ecker from the girls' tennis team, which won a 12<sup>th</sup> consecutive Tri-Eastern Conference title and a Sectional championship this season. The following girls' tennis players were honored at the meeting: Gabby Duke, Ava McCurdy, Kylar Marshall, Ashtyn Allen, Emma Cooper, and Gracie Helms. Mr. Osting introduced Coach Mike Day for the track teams. He recognized regional qualifiers Kendra Shipman, Kaylynn Wolfal, and Destinee Reece. He also introduced Avery McCoy from the boys' track team, who was a Sectional champion in the discus. Mr. Osting introduced Coach Aaron Roberts for the boys' golf team. He recognized Brady Moore for being a conference champion and advancing to the regional meet.

Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover to approve the Speech Language Pathologist Aide title change and pay rate increase. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation follows.

Dr. McCoy and Mr. Stevenson presented an update on the CAE building project. Mr. Stevenson said they have removed the fencing by the CARES door and have begun demolition on the bus parking lot. He said they have also completed interior drywall, cabinets, windows and storefront sills. They are getting close to completing the terrazzo and ceramic floor tile. The above ceiling inspection is complete. Expected completion of the building is still set for July 15. No action required.

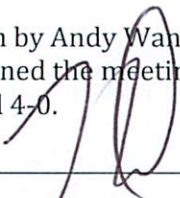
Additional Items:
