The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover to approve the consent items as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation follows.

The sidewalks on the west side of the elementary will be torn out and replaced starting tomorrow. The cost for the sidewalks are being shared with the town of Centerville. The soil that is under the old basketball courts has an issue. It needs to be replaced four-to-five feet deep. No action required.




Dr. McCoy said he is getting ready to sign the change order for the gas line that was moved earlier in the elementary building project.
