The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building. The following members were present: Todd Dooley, Todd Duke, Brad Lambright, Andy Wandersee, and Renee Westover. The public observed the meeting via in-person. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover to approve the consent items as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 5-0. Documentation follows.

Todd Duke thanked Jon and Connie Odom for their \$500 donation to the Class of 2024. This money will be used to help offset costs associated with Prom and Graduation for the students.

Mr. Pritchard introduced Rose Hamilton students who were winners of the Connersville Art Competition. Ms. Sizelove recognized Elizabeth Cox and Kalleigh Nobbe for their achievements.

Todd Duke opened the floor to community comments.

No one present chose to speak.

Old Business:

Mr. Stevenson presented quotes to replace the kitchen freezer at the high school for consideration. He said they received two quotes and one business said they could not give a quote due to time and distance. The two quotes are from Leisure Mechanical (\$37,868.88) and Polar King (\$45,168.85). He and Tami Scalzo are recommending the board accept the quote from Leisure because it is cheaper and they are local. This is the No. 1 item on the school's Spend Down Plan that was submitted to the DOE in Sept. 2022. Motion by Todd Dooley, second by Renee Westover to approve the quote from Leisure Mechanical to replace the freezer at Centerville Senior High School. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 5-0. Documentation follows.

New Business:

Dr. McCoy introduced the two team members from Cognia who are currently conducting the accreditation visit for the corporation. They were given time with the school board members to ask questions about the school corporation. No action required.

Dr. McCoy presented a discussion on accepting transfer applications for the 2023-24 school year for consideration. Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover to approve accepting transfer





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students for the 2023-24 school year. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 5-0. Documentation follows.

Dr. McCoy presented an update on the building projects. He said the metal panels are currently being installed. They are still working on the railings. They are also still trying to fix some of the door hardware issues. The transportation building is supposed to be delivered in mid-March. They started working on the foundation today, and the transformer could be delivered any day. Submittals have been completed on both the windows and the cooling tower projects. No action required.

Mr. Stevenson said there was no update on support services. He added that a catalytic converter was stolen off of one of the activity buses Tuesday night. That area has several surveillance cameras so the suspect was caught on camera and law enforcement is working on it. No action required.

Additional Items:

Todd Duke presented two additional professional development requests. Motion by Renee Westover, second by Andy Wandersee to accept the additional professional development requests. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 5-0. Documentation follows.

Todd Duke presented an additional employment report. Motion by Brad Lambright, second by Renee Westover to accept the additional employment report. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 5-0. Documentation follows.

Dr. McCoy reminded board members that he has reserved them spots at the ISTAR dinner at Connersville High School on March 8 at 6 p.m.

Dr. McCoy told the board that he would be looking at the policies and seeing if there are other options out there instead of NEOLA.

Todd Dooley thanked the board and Dr. McCoy for allowing him to attend a seminar presented by ISBA for new board members.

Brad Lambright said he attended the Chamber of Commerce meeting representing the board members from Centerville, and he said it was good to hear what other board members are dealing with. He also spoke about the junior and senior job fair he is currently helping with that is hosting students from the area schools.

Todd Duke said he will still send out something to board members about potential trainings in the future.





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Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Brad Lambright to adjourn the meeting. Todd Duke adjourned the meeting at 8:10 p.m. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 5-0.
