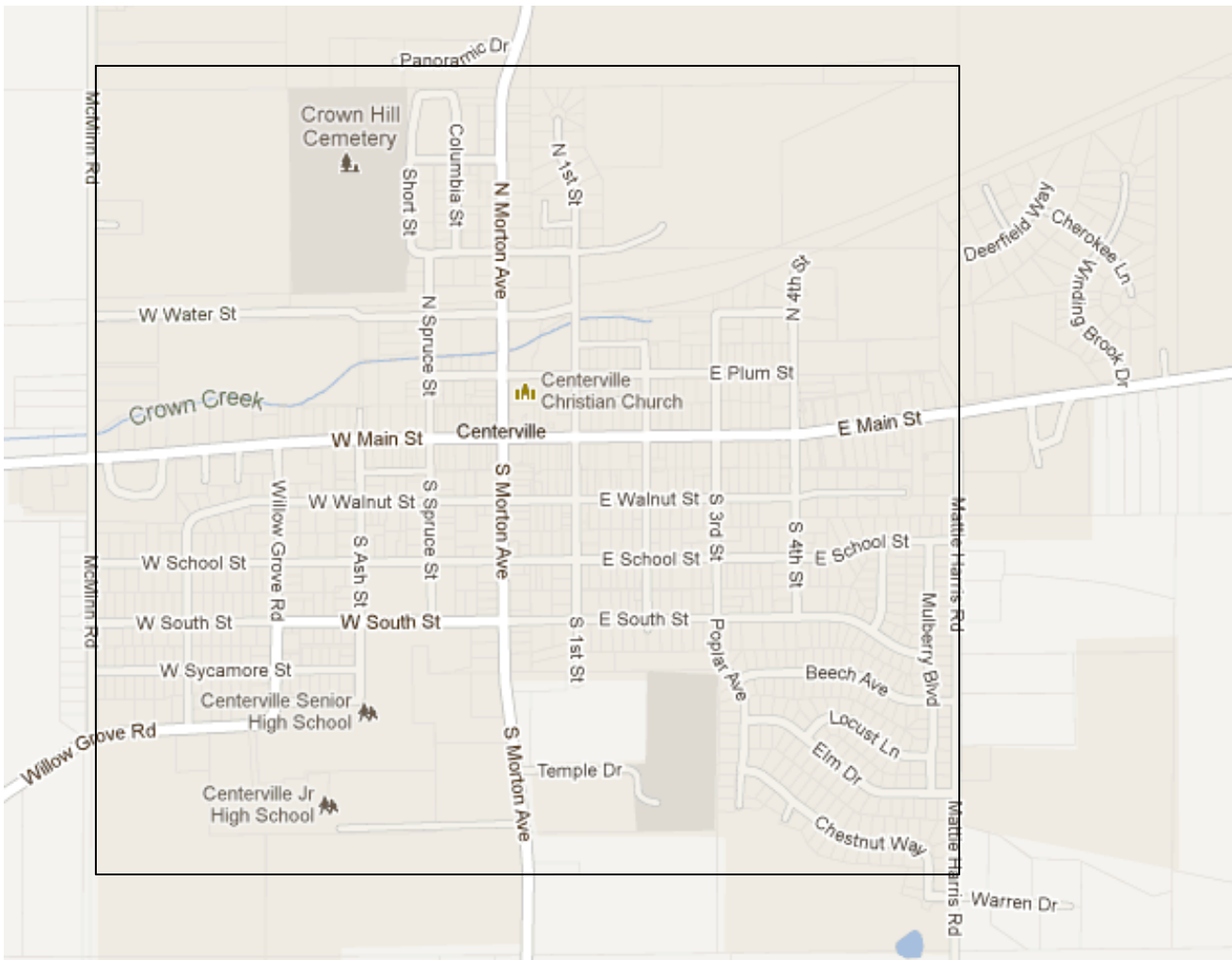


In accordance with Indiana Code 20-27-13-4, Centerville-Abington Community Schools has established SAFE WALK ZONES in specific areas of the corporation. Students inside the SAFE WALK ZONES are not eligible for school bus transportation.

Safe Walk Zone #1- Applies to K-12 students in and around the town of Centerville.

- The safe walking zone shall be defined as those areas that are one mile or less walking distance to the main entrance sidewalk of Centerville Senior High School in the most direct safe path. A safe path is defined as follows:
 - A. The path for all areas on the north side of Main Street (US 40) converge at the traffic device at the intersection of Main Street and Morton Street (Centerville Road)
 - B. The path for all areas south of Main Street (US 40) and east of Morton Street (Centerville Road) converge at the traffic device at the intersection of Morton Street (Centerville Road) and South Street.
 - C. Transportation will be provided in 30mph speed zones and higher if sidewalks are not present.
 - Note: K-2 elementary students are permitted to ride a transfer bus from Centerville-Abington Elementary to Rose Hamilton Elementary School.



Safe Walk Zone #2- Applies to K-2 students in the Rose Hamilton Schools area.

- The safe walking zone shall be defined as those areas that are one mile or less walking distance to the main entrance of Rose Hamilton Elementary and falls within the boundaries and intersections of Round Barn Road on the west, US 40 on the north, Salisbury Road on the east, and Test Road on the south; and specifically those areas that are east of and not bordering Round Barn, the area south of and including Crestwood Lane, all area West of Salisbury Road, and all area north of and not bordering Test Road with the most direct safe path to Rose Hamilton Elementary School. A safe path is defined as follows:
 - A. A safe path to school will consist of sidewalks where available. The sidewalk from Rose Hamilton to Highland Drive will be available to students and is used to determine the most direct route to and from Rose Hamilton. Any road crossings are to be done at intersections.
 - B. Students living along Round Barn Road or who would be required to walk along Round Barn Road will be eligible for transportation regardless of distance to school.
